

POLLUTION CATCHER

Learn how leaves clean our air!

Leaves are super special because they can catch pollution in the air. Some leaves have little hairs, some have a sticky surface, and some have little bumps. All of these things catch pollution! You are going to create your own pollution catcher!

Equipment:

- Paper / Card (laminated)
- Hole punch
- String
- Petroleum Jelly

Steps:

1. Cut out a leaf shape from the paper / card.
2. Punch a hole through the leaf, near the edge at the stem.
3. Tie a loop of string through the hole.
4. Apply a thin layer of petroleum jelly to the leaf.
5. Hang the leaf up in an area and check it to see what pollution it captures
