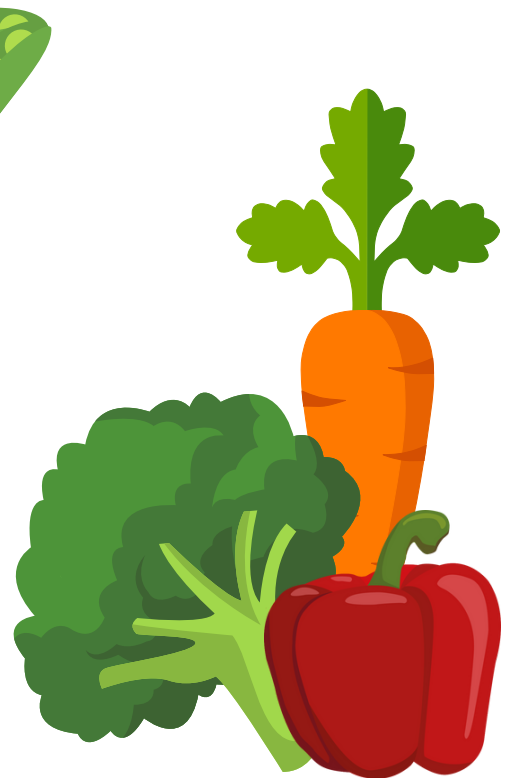
What senses do plants affect?
